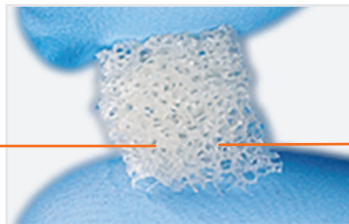
DESIGN RATIONALE

The naturally porous structure of cancellous bone combined with unique, sponge-like handling characteristics make Cancellous Sponge a suitable alternative to autograft.

FEATURES

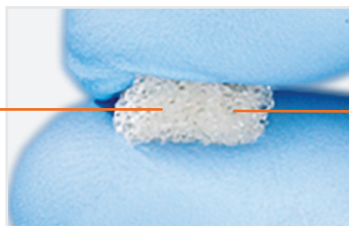
- Sponge-like properties allow product to compress to 30% of its original size then expand back to its original shape
- Demineralized cancellous bone with osteoinductive potential
- Sterilized using a validated gamma irradiation method with sterility assurance level (SAL) of 10^{-6}
- Donor screening in compliance with AATB standards and FDA regulations

for cellular in-growth



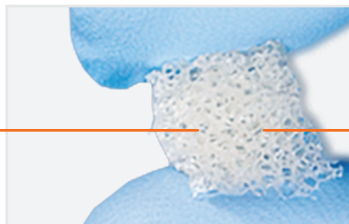
Demineralized to expose

minimize graft migration

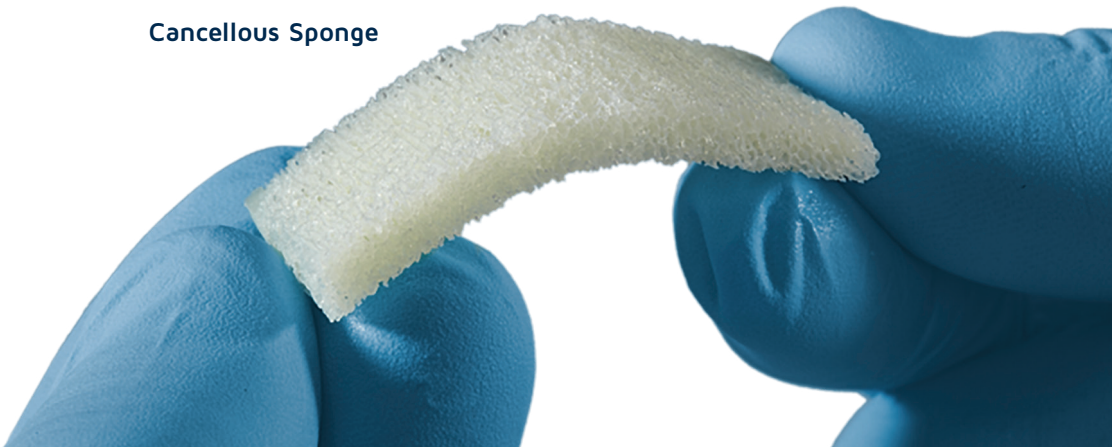
Absorbs bioactive fluids

Cancellous Sponge is a demineralized bone matrix that utilizes the natural porous structure of cancellous bone. Derived entirely from human bone, Cancellous Sponge is intended to support bone formation, providing a suitable alternative to autograft.
